This certificate course on systematic review covers both theory and hands-on experience. The participants are mentored by experts so that by the end of the program participants have a completed protocol, participants will be guided towards registering their protocol in Prospero and Protocol publication before they are ready to commence their review.

Who we are?

Public Health Evidence South Asia (PHESA) is an initiative which includes the South Asian satellite of Cochrane Public Health (CPH), based at Prasanna School of public Health, Manipal Academy of higher Education. PHESA aims to meet the public health evidence needs of the South Asian region. Presently, we have grown into an international network with global collaborations, including many universities, public health organizations and NGOs.

- To update and develop technical skills and knowledge in systematic reviews with latest methodologies
- To equip the participants to independently carry out the review after the course
- To build networks and collaborations with participants across professions working in the area of evidence synthesis
